How To Find Us

By car

From *Stuttgart* (180 km): Take the A 81 towards Singen, then follow the B33 towards Konstanz after Kreuz Hegau (the T interchange). Once in Konstanz, follow the signs to 'Universität'.

From *Munich* (220 km): Take the A 96 towards Lindau. Once in Lindau, follow the B 31 to Meersburg, from where you take the car ferry to Konstanz.

From *Zurich* (75 km): Take the A7 motorway towards Kreuzlingen/Konstanz. After you cross the border, first drive towards 'Mainau' until you see the signs pointing you towards 'Universität'. Important: A vignette must be obtained in order to drive on Swiss motorways.

By train

Destination: 'Konstanz'. Buses 9A and 9B go directly to the university.

By taxi

A taxi from the inner city of Konstanz to the university will cost around €15. There is a taxi queue outside the train station. Do *not* take a taxi from Zurich airport (see below).

By plane

There is an easy train connection between **Zurich Airport** and Konstanz. Many airlines have direct connections from across Europe to Zurich, often several times per day. Do *not* take a taxi from the airport to Konstanz, as the costs cannot be reimbursed (they can easily be above €200). Instead use the train services.

Two train connections leave from platform ("Gleis") 2 of the **Zurich Airport Station to Konstanz** main station every hour. You can take:

- a direct train which leaves for 'Konstanz' every hour between 06.46 and 22.46 and takes 1h04min (a last direct connection runs at 23.53).

- an indirect connection in-between: take the train heading towards 'Romanshorn' between 6.16am und 23.16 (from platform 2); leave the train at Weinfelden, where you have to wait for thirteen minutes), before you take the S14 to Konstanz, which runs from 7.06 until 0.06 (the journey usually continues from the same platform with a local stop train; note that several trains will depart around the same time, make sure you take the right one); the overall journey to Konstanz takes 1h20min.

Note: Zurich Airport train station is directly outside the arrivals terminal and it doesn't take more than five minutes to walk there; there is a ticket booth, although it can have a line during peak hours. Alternatively, you can buy a ticket at one of the machines. When using them, do not buy return tickets, since they are valid for same-day returns only, i.e. you will need two separate tickets (and can buy the return ticket in Konstanz). You can pay by credit card and won't need Swiss francs therefore. Online tickets can be bought at www.sbb.ch, or at www.bahn.de. Single trip ticket cost around CHF 30 or €28 for 2nd class.

Friedrichshafen Airport can be reached by different German and international airlines, but travelling to/from the airport is more complicated, since there is only an indirect route that requires changing means of transport. NB: Flights to Zurich also tend to be cheaper.

From the train station to the Bischofsvilla

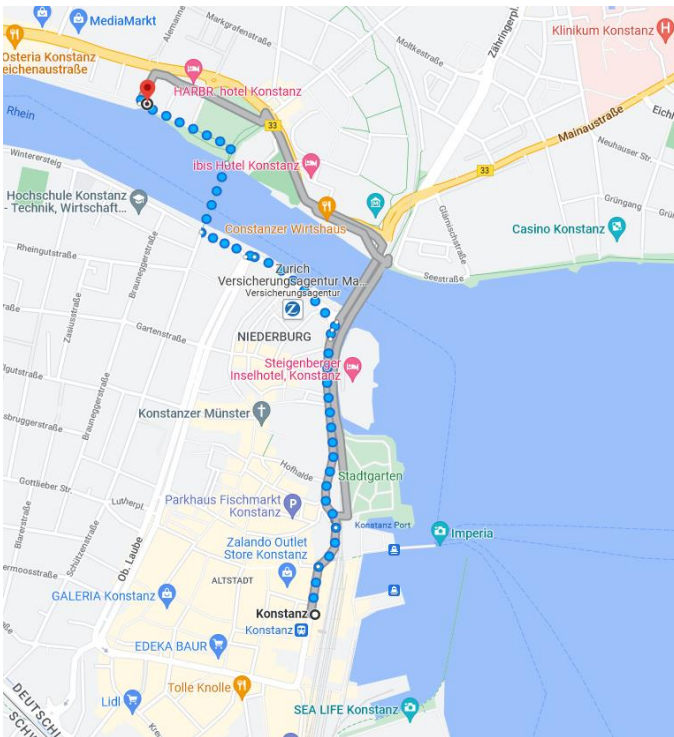
The Bischofsvilla is located at Otto-Adam-Straße 5, 78467 Konstanz and can easily be reached by car, bus, taxi or walking.

By car

Finding parking space near Bischofsvilla may be difficult. For that reason, we recommend using the public parking spaces at Bodenseeforum Konstanz, which is reasonably close to the venue (the fee is 3 € a day).

By bus

You may reach the bus station 'Am Rheinufer' close to Bischofsvilla directly from the main train station by taking the bus 13/4 in the direction of Konstanz Markstätte/Bahnhof. Travel time is ca. 5 minutes.



By taxi

There is a taxi stand located just in front of the train station. You can call and order a taxi anytime at +49 7531-22222 or +49 7531-66666. *Please note that taxi costs during daytime can only be reimbursed under special conditions (such as limitations of mobility).*

Walking

It takes approximately 20 minutes to walk to the Bischofsvilla. You may follow the map on the left for indications on how to get there.
